



## FRIDAY NIGHT

Verses used this session: 2 Chronicles 33:9, 2 Chronicles 34:1-2

1. If you became king at 8 years old, like Josiah, what would be the first thing you did?
2. If you could summarize your story so far in 5 words, what would they be?
3. If you could summarize what you hope your future will be like in 5 words, what words would you use?
4. How did you feel about the “If You Really Knew Me” Survey? Even though it’s anonymous, did you find yourself hesitant to answer honestly?
5. Did any of your own answers to the survey surprise you?

## SATURDAY MORNING

Verses Used this Session:

2 Chronicles 34:3, Deuteronomy 6:4-5, 2 Kings 22:11, John 3:16, Psalm 34:18, Romans 5:8, 2 Kings 22:13

1. When you’re craving a midnight snack, what’s your go to food? what are common idols that people tend to worship without even realizing it? (money, popularity, sex, grades/school, work, etc)
2. When the book of the law was found, Josiah may have been hearing for the first time that God loved him. Do you remember the first time you heard that? How did it impact you?
3. Jeremy talked about 2 lies that Satan uses to stop us from changing our story - “You’re all alone” and “You’re too far gone”. Have either of those ever felt true of you?
4. In 2 Kings 22:13, Josiah sent his aides to go inquire of the Lord for Him (meaning they were going to consult a prophetess named Huldah, in case you were wondering).
5. If I were to go inquire of the Lord on your behalf, what would you want me to ask him?



## SATURDAY NIGHT

Verses used this session:

2 Kings 23:3-5, Romans 6:23, Luke 4:3-12, Romans 5:8

1. Have you ever had an injury that you just ignored hoping it would go away?

Josiah's reaction to his nation's sin (2 Kings 23) was pretty immediate and extreme. If you were him, how would you have handled the news?

2. If you found out news like Josiah did, but about yourself, how would you react?

3. Jeremy talked about how we tend to "tune out" the sin in our own lives. Why do you think we do that?

4. We looked at Luke 4:3-12 and how Satan tempted Jesus with Stuff, Status, and Self. If Satan were tempting you, how might he attack you in those areas?
